We are seeking an individual to support the cross-Canada bicycle tour, Tour du Canada. Tour du Canada is a non-profit corporation where cycling participants share in the responsibilities and success of the tour. The tour was first held in 1988 and we are now celebrating 30 plus years of cross-Canada bicycle rides. To learn more about the tour please visit: www.TourduCanada.com

The position starts and ends in Alliston, Ontario. The 16 week contract begins May 21, 2022. Entry level salary is \$10,500.00 for the 16-week term; plus an optional bonus up to \$2500.00. Room and board is provided for the entire term.

Beginning May 21 there is a three-week training period (included in the paid term) where you will become familiar with the equipment, practise driving, learn company policies and procedures and support a weekend tour with 1-2 other employees. In mid-June you will drive to Vancouver for the start of the bicycle tour. Each day of the tour you will drive from point to point, daily distances averaging 140km, transporting rider gear, purchasing supplies and checking in and out of campgrounds. Record keeping of expenses and driving hours is a daily task. You will be away from your home base for the summer. Days off are at locations such as Banff, Thunder Bay, Ottawa and Quebec City. The tour ends in early September in St. John's Newfoundland and from there you return to Alliston.

Ontario G driver's license (or equivalent from other province).

Ability to drive or learn to drive pickup with trailer.

You will be required to provide a driver's abstract and a three-year insurance claims history and be insurable.
